Proclamation

WHEREAS: A Day to Honor Victims of Terrorism 2005 provides an opportunity to focus worldwide attention on the impact terrorism has on people around the world; and

WHEREAS: November 24, 2005, marks the 20th Anniversary of EgyptAir Flight #648, when three gunmen, calling themselves the Egypt Revolution, took control of a flight traveling from Athens to Cairo; and

WHEREAS: Fifty-nine passengers were killed as a result of this act of terrorism; and

WHEREAS: Today we recognize the many lives that have been forever changed and remember the lives that have been lost to terrorism.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM PAWLENTY, Governor of Minnesota, proclaim Thursday, November 24, 2005, to be:

A DAY TO HONOR VICTIMS OF TERRORISM 2005

in the State of Minnesota.
